I hereby request permission to have an unattended temporary power supply from the Marina Electrical Comsen Unit Power module to my vessel.

The temporary supply will be connected to one portable device only

Please detail what the power will be connected to:

The following conditions must be met to ensure compliance with the Electrical Regulations 1997, NZS:3004

- All components of the supply lead shall be appropriately rated for the demands placed upon them.
- The supply lead shall be in one continuous length, and shall not exceed 20 metres in length.
- The power cable shall be a heavy duty tough rubber sheathed cable with all conductors including the protective earthing conductor integral within the sheathing.
- The supply lead shall be arranged to:
  - Permit normal movement of the craft at its mooring without undue stress;
  - Prevent water flowing along the supply lead from reaching the appliance inlet;
  - Reduce the likelihood of the plug or appliance lead falling in the water;
  - Minimize the possibility of accidental disconnection.(The cable shall be restrained both ends)
- Cables are to be laid in such a manner that they are prevented from being
  - Displaced by movements of the vessel;
  - Damaged due to friction, pull or pressure (squashing);
  - a tripping hazard to persons accessing the Pier.

As the owner/agent of the above vessel I confirm I have read the above conditions and further state that the power will be connected to one portable device only and shall not be connected to the vessel's onboard power reticulation system.
