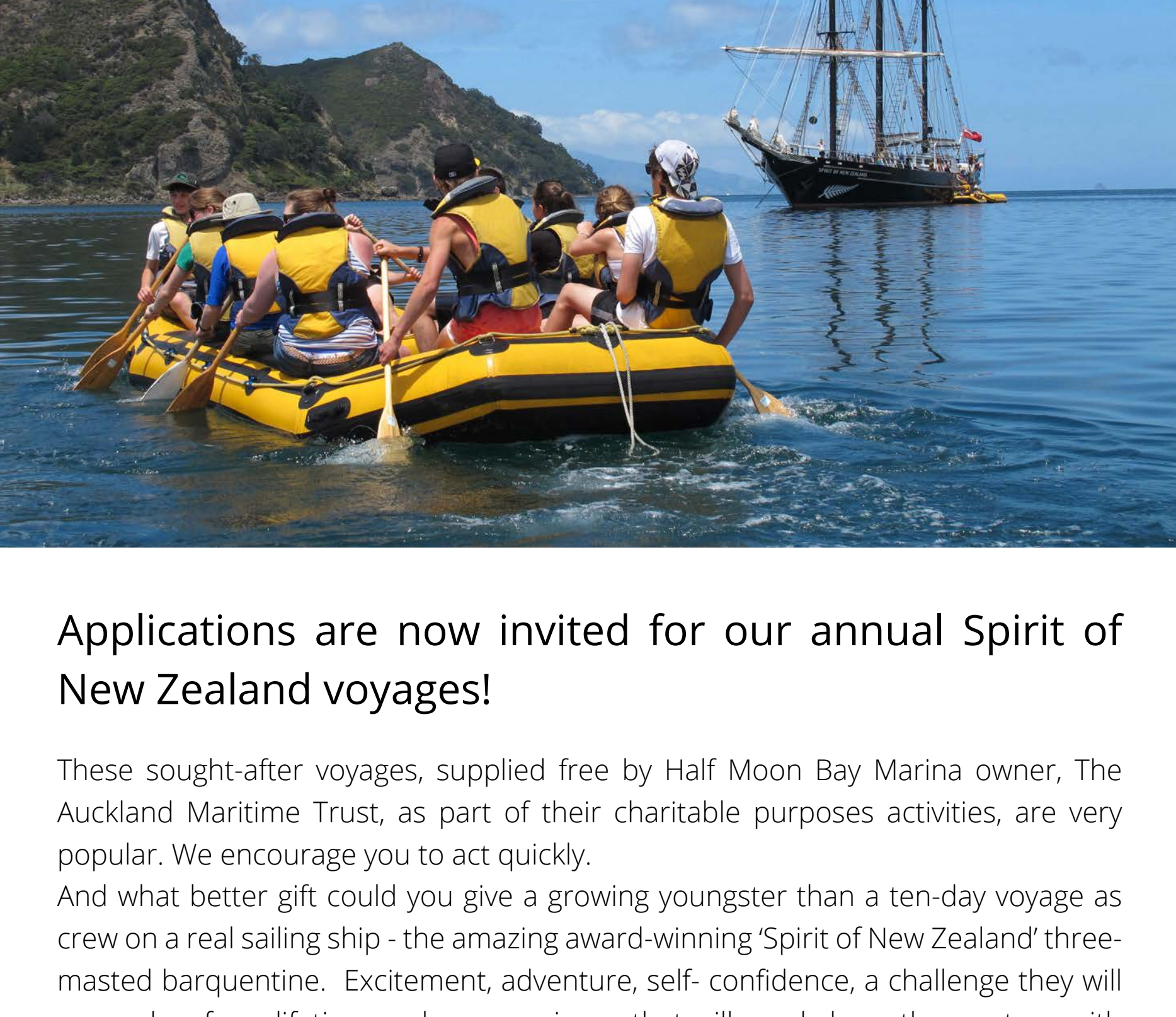

Applications are now open !



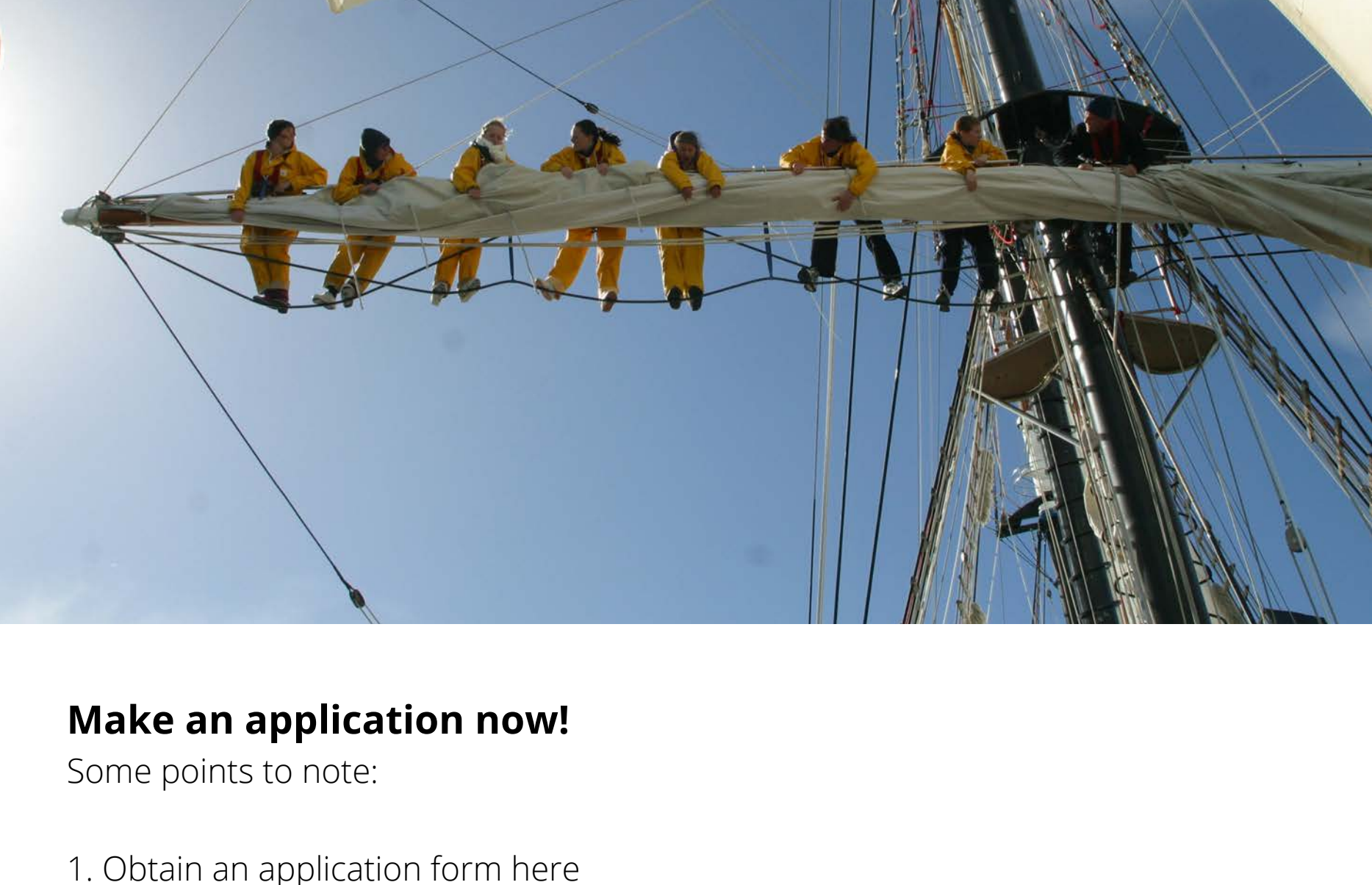
Applications are now invited for our annual Spirit of New Zealand voyages!

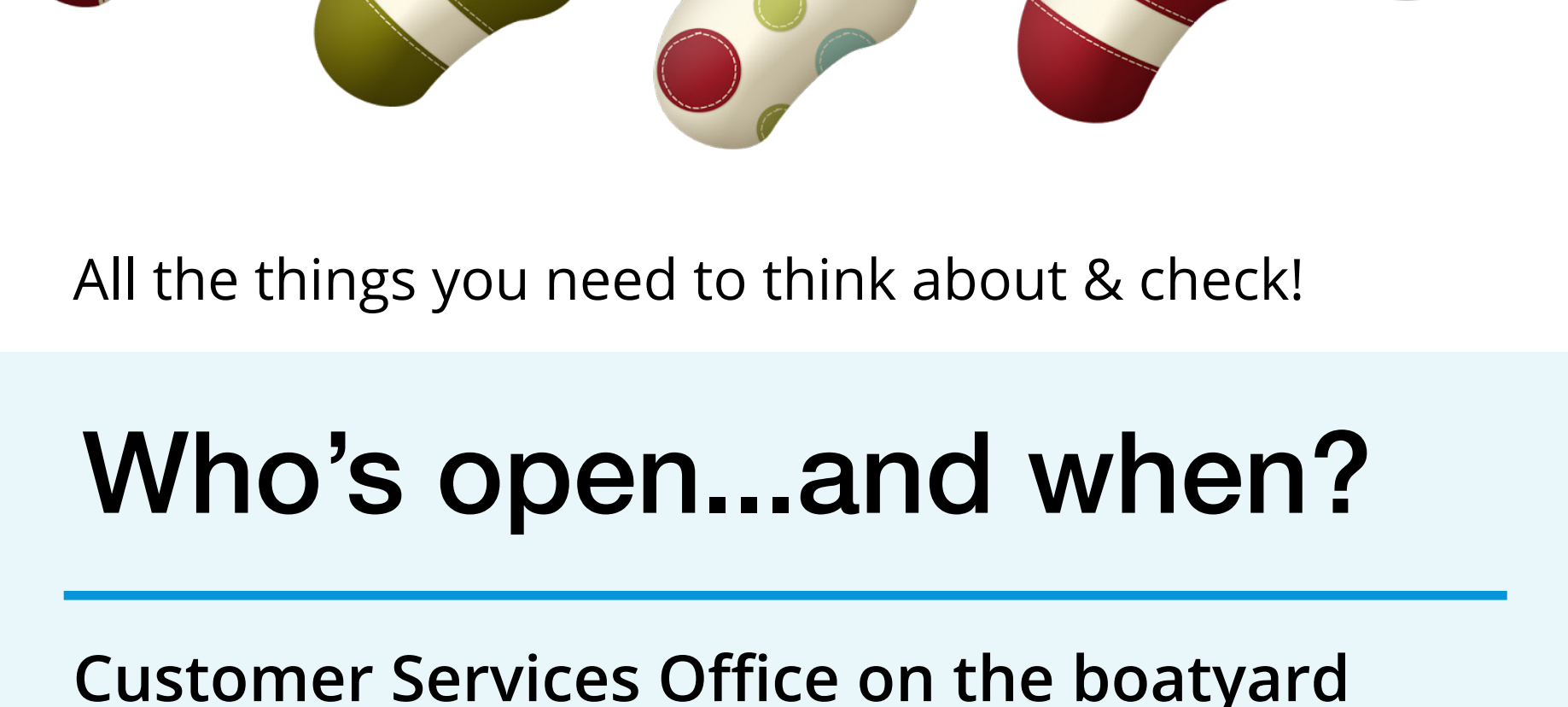
4. Also on the website is the 2020 sailing schedule from which you can choose a date that best suits your Nominees calendar .

CONTACT DATA - Do we have your up-to-date details?

And be wary of strangers especially those asking to be let through gates. Any doubts, report their presence. Think of your pier neighbours.

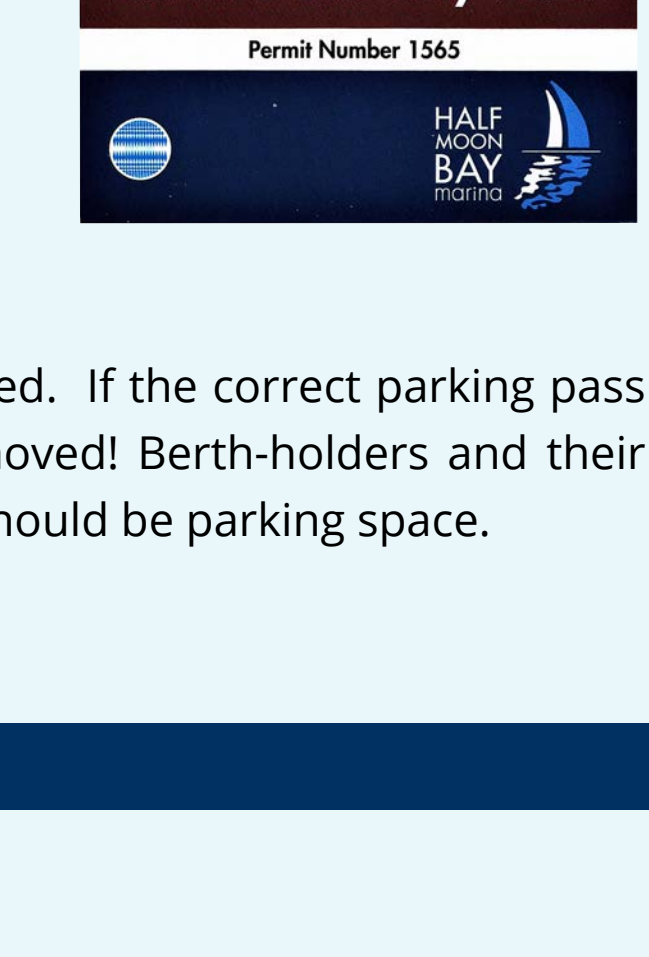
Parking

GOING AWAY? - Please don't park your vehicle near the pier gate

If you're away for an extended period, think of your pier neighbours who remain.

PARKING PASSES MUST BE DISPLAYED

All parking zones in the Marina will be monitored. If the correct parking pass is not clearly displayed the vehicle will be removed! Berth-holders and their guests should find parking space where there should be parking space.



Housekeeping

Don't use your pier as storage space

Piers and fingers must be kept absolutely clear of any obstruction. Remove loose hoses and any trip hazards. Any gear should be stowed on your vessel. Please observe Marina Security requests.

Please return pier trolleys to the gate and store correctly

Please consider your fellow boaties and return the trolleys after you have finished loading or unloading your boat. Even more necessary in the busy season. Please don't leave handles protruding into walkways. Thanks.

Check mooring lines

Don't be caught short in a summer gale. Check you lines and keep your vessel safe. Old and worn gear should be replaced. Don't take the risk.
